

DANIEL'S SEVENTY WEEKS AND THE DAY OF THE LORD

- ❖ There are only 3.5 years remaining, not seven, according to Revelation 11:2, 3
- ❖ The period known as "the day of the Lord" inserts Daniel's 70th Week into a time gap that commenced with Israel's rejection of God under Samuel's leadership (I Samuel 8:6-8) and will end with the new heaven, the new earth, and the New Jerusalem (Rev. 21:1, 2)
- ❖ See why for 36.5 years after the Crucifixion the priestly practice of animal sacrifice yielded "the overspreading of abominations" which in turn produced a sacrifice that was "desolate," or empty. This quintessential act of disobedience led to the beginning of the Jewish Diaspora from Palestine
- ❖ The Jews have covered up and deliberately falsified their own chronology while substituting Simon Bar Kokhba (135 A.D.) as their messiah instead of Jesus Christ

THE TWILIGHT OF THE LAST DAYS AND THE LAST 3.5 YEARS

- ❖ The "beginning of sorrows" are the five seals of Revelation 6, while the 'trigger' is the construction of the Jewish temple ushering in the last 3.5 years

THE FALLING AWAY

- ❖ The "falling away" (II Thess. 2:3) started at the Incarnation and continues to the present. The falling away is from the truth of God's Word. The battle cry of the faithful today is biblical inerrancy, transmission, and preservation --purity (the heart of the translation issue)
- ❖ The one-world harlot church and the spirit of ecumenical compromise is creating a massive deception on a global scale. This "strong delusion" is constructing a monstrous lie (the human potential movement) that will damn untold multitudes who hold the truth in unrighteousness (II Thess. 2:10-12)
- ❖ The knowledge of God's Word has given way to subjective human experience (The Tongues Movement within Protestantism; Fatima within Roman Catholicism) which have opened the floodgates to Satan's power, counterfeit signs, and lying wonders (II Thess. 2:9)

THE GREAT TRIBULATION AND THE TRIBULATION

- ❖ According to sound exegesis, the phrase "those days" found in Matthew 24:19, 22, 29, connects the great tribulation and the tribulation. The conclusion: we are not anticipating the tribulation, we are in it! The word "Immediately" in Matthew 24:29 means next in prophetic sequence

ISRAEL

- ❖ Seventy weeks are still being determined upon God's people: spiritual Israel (the remnant--Romans 2:28, 29) and national Israel (the Jewish state-- Isaiah 19:25)

THE TERMINAL GENERATION

- ❖ We cannot know the day, nor the hour, but we are encouraged to know the sign of the times. In Jesus parable of the fig tree (Matthew 24:32-34) the Lord said that the generation which witnessed Israel become a nation would not pass until his prophetic promises were fulfilled

MATTHEW 24:36; MARK 13:32--WAS JESUS CHRIST LORD?

- ❖ Learn the danger of a faulty interpretation of this passage. It has led many to conclude the Incarnation made the Messiah less than LORD.
